Advanced clinical training program for foreign medical practitioners

Documents to be submitted for the permit

- 1. One photocopy of your medical practitioner's license. If the applicant is from a country which does not issue medical licenses, he/she must prove that they may be lawfully engaged in the practice of medicine in their country. Specifically, the applicant must submit a public certificate, such as one issued by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare of their home country, which states that medical licenses are not issued by their government, and, in addition they must submit a certificate providing their right to engage in medical practice, such as a diploma (the original and one photocopy) from their medical school.
- 2. Documentation proving at least three years' clinical experience.
 Documentation proving at least three years' clinical experience as a medical practitioner after receiving the medical license (or an equivalent qualification) is required. The applicant must submit a certificate regarding the duration of their employment, issued by the director of the medical facilities where they have experience in the practice of medicine. (This certificate has to be signed by the director of the medical facilities or a person of equivalent position. A signature by division chief, department director, vice director, etc. will not be accepted.)
- 3. Two photographs (full-faced without a hat, 3 cm x 2 cm, taken not more than six months prior to the date of application).
 - One photograph (full-faced without a hat, $4 \text{ cm } \times 3 \text{ cm}$, taken not more than six months prior to the date of application).
- * One document per one item is required. If several items are mentioned in one document, it is not acceptable.
